Why only this pie

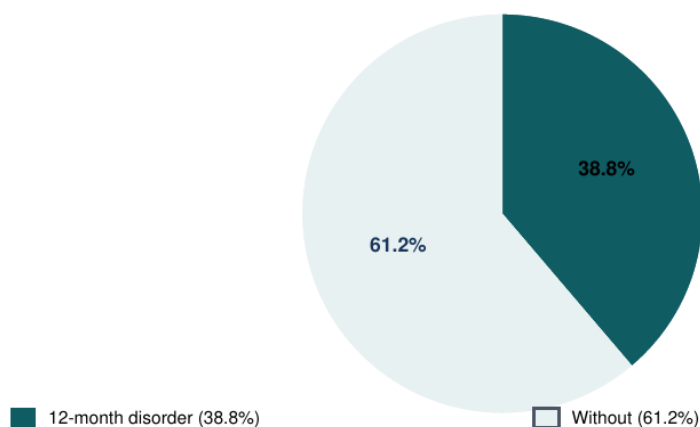
Anxiety, mood, and substance-use disorders can overlap in the same person. A pie of those groups would double-count. The only pie allowed here is a clean partition of the same ABS 16–24 persons rate.

Partition (Australia, 16–24, 2020–22)

- 38.8% — 12-month mental disorder
- 61.2% — without a 12-month mental disorder
- These two parts add to 100%.

16-24 Australia 2020-22 · partition only (ABS)

38.8% with 12-month disorder · 61.2% without. Not an overlapping-type pie.



ABS NSMHW 2020-22 · Do NOT pie anxiety/mood/substance (they overlap)

Partition pie only. Source: ABS NSMHW 2020–22.

Do not draw overlapping disorder pies (anxiety / mood / substance).
